**Mary Victoria Borden**

Lacey- Mary Victoria Borden, 73, a former longtime Wishkah Valley resident, died Tuesday at her home here. She was born March 16, 1913, in Nekoosa, Wis.

She attended schools in Wisconsin and had worked in a paper mill there before coming to the Wishkah Valley in 1947 from Akron, Ohio.

She and her husband Bill bought the Wishkah Valley store in 1958 and operated it for 14 years. They sold the store in 1972 and moved to Central Park. He died in 1972.

She had lived in Raymond for a short time and for the past six months she had lived in Lacey.

She is survived by two sons, Henry J. and Russell G., both of Olympia, a daughter Mary Belle Stuhr of Raymond, a brother Joseph Szyjka of Nekoosa, Wis., two sisters, Genevieve Newell of Nekoosa and Delores Zdorkowski of Sheboygan, Wis; and two grandchildren. A graveside service is scheduled.
