December 2, 1999 Longtime Aberdonian Lulu May Lash, 82, died Thursday, Dec. 2, 1999, in Grays Harbor Community Hospital at Aberdeen. Mrs. Lash was born Dec. 31, 1916, in Aberdeen to John and Hetty (Mack) McBride. She was raised in Aberdeen. During World War n, she worked for the Boeing Co. at Hoquiam. On Aug. 29, 1945, she married Mike R. Lash in Aberdeen. They lived there until moving to Quinault in 1959. Her husband died in 1969, and Mrs. Lash Returned to Aberdeen the following year. She enjoyed sewing, crocheting, crossword puzzles and reading. She was known as a good cook. Survivors include two sons, Mike R. of Westport and William of Aberdeen; a daughter, Carol Elder of Bend, Ore.; a sister, Kathryn Merrill of Hoquiam; eight grandchildren and 12 great-grandchildren. Four brothers, Lawrence "Tiddle," Chester, William and John McBride, and five sisters, Elva Pirhala, Ethel Scott, Mary Gosso, Hettie Ditton and Gladys Rice, all died before her. She was cremated.
