GLORIA DAWN DUNCAN

Gloria D. Duncan, 72, a resident of the Wishkah Valley for over 50 years, died at Grays Harbor Community Hospital, Friday, June 23, 2006. She was born in Decorah, Iowa on April 8, 1934, to August and Ragna (Helgeson) White. At the age of two she came with her family to the Harbor and had lived in North River, Aberdeen, Hoquiam and in 1949, settled in the Wishkah Valley. She was a graduate of Wishkah High School in 1952, as the class salutatorian and attended Grays Harbor College in Aberdeen.

On July 21, 1956, she married Robert Duncan in Aberdeen. They lived in Hoquiam before moving to the Wishkah Valley in 1962. Mr. Duncan died here in 1991. Gloria worked as a bookkeeper for Grays Harbor Plywood and after moving to the valley was the first secretary at the Wishkah School. She and her husband owned and operated Duncan's Grocery in Wishkah for two years and then built a home in the valley. She went back to work as bookkeeper for Quigg Brothers on the Port Dock. She later worked in the office at L&B Refrigeration, retiring in 1986. Gloria was a member of the Wishkah Valley Community Church, Olympians Hiking Club and the Sons of Norway. She enjoyed gardening, genealogy, traveling with friends and spending time with her grandchildren. She is survived by a son, Robert of Wishkah Valley; three daughters, Cindy Matthews and Gwen Hamilton both of Wishkah Valley, and Lynne Fries of Aberdeen; two brothers, Clyde and John White both of Wishkah Valley; a sister, Leanne Arnold of Wishkah Valley; and also 12 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren. A brother, Ted White, died before her in 2003.

Visitation will be from 1-8 p.m. Wednesday June 28, 2006, in the chapel at Fern Hill Funeral Home. A graveside service will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday, June 29, 2006, at St. John's Cemetery in Wishkah Valley, with the Reverend Ron Roberts of Pacific Beach officiating.
